



Telecitigroup Expands London Data Centres



To meet your anticipated need for data centre space, Telecitigroup has launched three key initiatives in the UK; these include the fit-out of new greenfield data centre in Central London and significant expansion of our existing facilities at Oliver's Yard (City) and Sovereign House (Docklands). The developments add significant high-density and managed hosting capacity to Telecitigroup's UK footprint.

Powergate: New data centre for London

We have launched our eighth facility in London. This impressive facility in West London centre will offer:

- Over **5,000m²** of capacity with **25 megawatts** of resilient power
- Average customer power of approximately **4kW** per rack
- High density zones offering up to **20kW** per rack
- Live presence from LINX offering global peering and connectivity
- Connectivity to major telecoms and network service providers
- Linked to Telecitigroup European data centres by our fibre network
- Ready for customers in Q2 2008

Oliver's Yard: Two new developments

We have also undertaken a major expansion of our key City based Oliver's Yard data centre to create:

- **230m²** of high-density space offering up to 20kW per rack – available now
- **550m²** of additional capacity of up to 3kW per rack available in Q3 2008

Sovereign House: Additional space

Finally we are constructing an additional **1,000m²** of data centre space, offering **2kW/rack** at our Sovereign House facility in London's Docklands, due for completion by the third quarter of 2008.
